We work globally. Our current focus is on Nepal, Liberia, Trinidad & Tobago, St. Lucia and key urban centers in the USA.

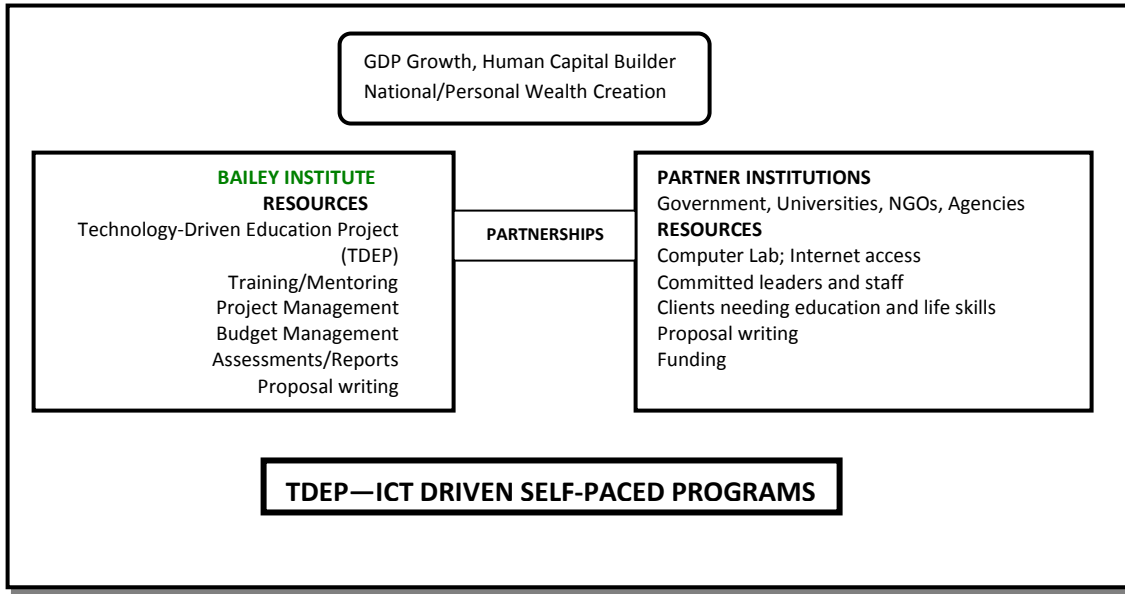
**3-Where is Bailey institute located?**
