2011 TDEP Budget

BI estimates that the Summer 2011 TDEP project in Liberia will cost about \$58,000 for 500 students. This includes \$4500 for in-country training of trainers, \$7200 for travel for two trainers who will perform that training, and \$15,000 for student license fees and registration. \$7500 is set aside for project review, and the rest of the budget is devoted to weekly and monthly review of student progress.
